Supervisor Freeman called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Notification of this meeting was given to the Press on April 12, 2008 and the final agenda was posted in the three designated places on April 14, 2008.

<u>Approve Monthly Town Board Minutes:</u> Motion was made by Sup. Wundrock to accept the March Monthly Town Board Minutes. Seconded by Supervisor Freeman. Motion carried.

<u>Treasurer:</u> (a) <u>Approve Monthly Report:</u> Motion was made by Sup.Freeman/Sup. Wundrock to approve the March 31, 2008 Treasurer's Report as read. Motion carried. (b) <u>Payment of Road Construction Loan-Discussion/Possible Action:</u> Motion was made by Sup. Wundrock/Sup. Freeman to authorize Treasurer Grove to proceed with paying off the Road Construction Loan at this time. Motion carried.

<u>Budget/Vouchers:</u> Approval & Payment of Vouchers: Motion was made by Sup. Wundrock/Sup. Freeman to approve payment of Vouchers 21493 through 21547, with exception of Void Check Number 21494, dated March 18, 2008 through April 21, 2008, and Direct Withdrawal of Social Security, Medicare and Federal Taxes of \$1,995.60 and Direct Withdrawal of (March 21st & April 21st) Monthly Interest Payment on the Road Construction Loan of \$391.68, for a total of \$102,912.19. <u>Public Forum - Town of Mukwa Residents: Lee Shaw-Klatt Road</u>: Mr. Shaw was inquiring about the disposal of the new energy-efficient light bulbs, as they contain hazardous materials and are not supposed to go to the landfill. Roger Holman, Director of Waupaca County Solid Waste was present and answered questions regarding this subject. Residents are urged to take these bulbs to the Waupaca County facility in Manawa.(there is a small fee). Recommended to include some information in the next newsletter. <u>Tom Handschke-Bean City Road</u>: Mr. Handschke inquired as to when the Town would do a Tire Clean Sweep. The Board will include this in a newsletter as well. Dan Deeg from Bean City Bar & Grill offered the Town use of the parking lot for a tire sweep.

<u>Variances:</u> (a)<u>Paul Beyer-Edgewood Drive:</u> Motion was made by Sup. Wundrock/Sup. Freeman that the Town Board go on record as approving/being in favor of a variance of 6 feet so that Mr. Beyer can add a porch to the front of his house. Sup. Wundrock edited motion that the edge of the porch would be 44 feet from the edge of the road and 54 feet from the edge of the center-line, per the recommendation of the Town of Mukwa Building Inspector. Motion carried.

Mukwa Area First Responders-Funding Concerns/Needs: Mukwa Area First Responder and Mukwa resident Phil Popke gave a small presentation to those present regarding what the group does, who they serve and the supplies and insurance (\$2,000 annually) necessary to keep this group going. They are asking for a donation from the Town to help pay for insurance and equipment. Mr. Popke mentioned that they would send a letter to Town residents. The Board requested that the Mukwa Area First Responders, which currently consists of nine members, also approach the other surrounding municipalities that they serve, ie. Lebanon, Caledonia, Royalton. A spot will be reserved for this group to write an article in the Town newsletter. This will be included on a future agenda.
