Approve July 20, 2009 Public Hearing Minutes Regarding the Discontinuing that Portion of Ferry Street Located South of the Wolf River: Motion was made by Sup. Wundrock/Sup. Freeman to accept the printed minutes of the Public Hearing to vacate that portion of Ferry Street located South of the Wolf River dated July 20, 2009. Motion carried.

<u>Approve Monthly Town Board Meeting Minutes:</u> Motion was made by Sup. Wundrock to accept the July 20, 2009 Monthly Town Board Minutes as printed. A second to the motion was made by Sup.Freeman. Motion carried.

<u>Treasurer:</u> <u>Approve Monthly Treasurer's Report:</u> Motion was made by Sup.Wundrock/Sup. Freeman to approve the July 31, 2009 Treasurer's Report as read. Motion carried.

<u>Budget/Vouchers:</u> <u>Approval & Payment of Vouchers:</u> Motion was made by Sup. Wundrock/Sup. Freeman to approve payment of Vouchers 22318 through 22359, dated July 21, 2009 through August 27, 2009, and Direct Withdrawal of Social Security, Medicare, and Federal Taxes of \$1,191.96, for a total of \$63,318.73. <u>Public Forum - Town of Mukwa Residents:</u> Lee Shaw-Klatt Road expressed concerns about the visibility issues/concerns at the intersection of Weyauwega Road and Broadway Street. Several people have expressed these same issues for several years. While you are on Weyauwega Road and need to make a left turn, it is necessary to creep into the intersection to properly see. Chairman Curns will contact the property owner to ask them to trim the trees up.

<u>County Supervisor</u>: County Supervisor, Bob Flease was present and reported that the County had acquired a counter for conducting speed studies. Supervisor Flease advised that the counter was available for municipalities to use for a week. Just contact if/when it is needed. This equipment records speed, number count and can differentiate between trucks and cars

<u>Davel Engineering-Submittal of Certified Survey Map for a 1-acre Parcel Split on Hutchison Road:</u> Motion was made by Chairman Curns/Sup.Wundrock to approve the 1-acre split on Hutchison Road (Matt Schoultz), contingent upon approval by the Town of Mukwa Plan Commission at the September 2nd Monthly Plan Commission Meeting. Motion carried.

Wolf River Trips & Campground-Update to July 20th Monthly Meeting: Mark Flease was present to represent the Campground. Mr. Flease presented the board with sample wristbands that have been implemented and reported that program is helping. Mr. Flease advised that several State agencies visited the campground for inspections-Campground passed each inspection. The Waupaca County Sheriff's Department did not submit any additional information since the July meeting-Board Member will contact. <u>Roads:</u> (a)<u>Monthly Report:</u> Snowplow truck repairs have been completed. Chairman Curns advised of an upcoming Road Equipment Trade Show in Madison. Motion was made by Sup.Freeman/Sup.Wundrock to authorize Chairman Curns to attend the Trade Show for Snowplow Equipment in Madison. Motion carried. (b)<u>Road Equipment-Report/Repairs/ Purchases Needed:</u> (1)Garage Door Repairs: Repairs scheduled for September. (2)Pressure Washer: Treasurer Grove offered the use of her pressure washer and ladders. Sup. Wundrock/Sup. Freeman made a motion to

postpone any purchase of a pressure washer until we have had a chance to take up the generous offer from the Treasurer Grove. Motion carried. (c) Possible 2009 Projects/Work Needed: (1) Ditch Excavating: Several projects throughout the Town need to be done. Town has used the Waupaca County Highway Commission in the past, with favorable results. The Town could rent a mini excavator and have our own maintenance personnel do the work. The culvert/ditch east of the intersection of Weyauwega Rd/Ferry St needs attention. Motion was made by Sup. Wundrock/Sup. Freeman to authorize Chairman Curns to continue to look into the rental of mini excavator/ditch excavating equipment. Motion carried. (d)S Larry Road: (1)Approve Omnni Contract for a Speed/Road Study: Omnni recommended that the study occur once school begins to get a true picture of traffic on said road for the speed study. Borings throughout the length of the road will be done to obtain information on the structural integrity of said road. Motion was made by Sup. Wundrock/Sup. Freeman to hire Omnni Associates for both the traffic speed study of South Larry Road as well as the structural analysis of South Larry Road contingent upon that results back to the Board before the September 21st Monthly Meeting. With the cost broken down as \$1,900.00 for the speed study and \$900.00 for the structural portion. Motion carried. (2)Feedback on Milk Hauler Letters Previously Sent: In our original mailings, letters were not sent to Saputo. Supervisor Wundrock will contact the manager, Kevin Sweeney, to advise him of the situation. (e)Forward Contract Road Salt: Motion was made by Sup. Wundrock/Sup. Freeman to authorize Chairman Curns to pursue a minimum of 150 ton (salt) in a negotiation process with Waupaca County Highway Department and/or MCC. Motion carried. Will be added to the September Agenda. (f) Approve Snowplow Driver-Tim Wheeler: Motion was made by Sup. Wundrock/Sup. Freeman to approve Tim Wheeler as a consideration for a snowplow operator contingent upon a positive report from his doctor, clearing him for work, before the Board would consider final approvals. Motion carried. (g)Waupaca County Equipment Availability for Speed Studies: County Supervisor Flease mentioned this previously. We will assess this issue and utilize this equipment as needed.
