Please take notice that a Public Hearing shall be held at 5:30 p.m. on Tuesday, October 9, 2018, at the Mukwa Town Hall, E8514 Weyauwega Road, New London, Wisconsin for consideration of the preliminary resolution to reduce the width of Broadway Street which was adopted by the Mukwa Town Board at the August 7, 2018 Monthly Town Board Meeting.

Question & Answer: The Town residents present were asking for clarification that Broadway Street was not going to be "physically" narrowed. The Board explained that for some unknown reason & unknown to the Town that Broadway Street was an eighty foot right-of-way instead of the standard sixty-six foot right-of-way & that right-of-way was beginning to impede residents from doing maintenance to their property. This procedure is the only legal way of changing the right-of-way to the standard sixty-six feet.
