Proof of identification must be provided before an absentee ballot may be issued.

The deadline for making application to vote absentee by mail is 5:00 p.m. on the fifth day before the election, (Thursday, March 29, 2018).

Special absentee voting application provisions apply to electors who are indefinitely confined to home or a care facility, in the military, hospitalized, or serving as a sequestered juror. If this applies to you, contact Clerk Zielinski regarding deadlines for requesting & submitting an absentee ballot.

The first day to vote an absentee ballot in the Clerk's Office is: *Monday, March 19, 2018.*

The deadline for voting an absentee ballot in the Clerk's Office is 5:00 p.m. on

Friday, March 30th.

The Municipal Clerk will deliver voted ballots returned on or before Election day to the proper polling place or counting location before THE POLLS CLOSE ON (Tuesday, April 3, 2018). Any ballots received after the polls close will not be counted.

Notice of Meeting of the Local and Municipal Board of Canvassers

At the close of voting on Election Day, pursuant to the provisions of Wis. Stat. § 19.84, the Election Inspectors will convene as a joint meeting of the Local Board of Canvassers and the Municipal Board of Canvassers for the purpose of conducting the local and municipal canvasses pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§7.51 and 7.53(1). This meeting will be open to the public pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ 19.81-89.
