The deadline for making application to vote absentee by <u>mail</u> is 5:00 p.m. on the fifth day before the election, (Thursday, August 4, 2016).

(Military electors should contact the municipal clerk regarding the deadlines for requesting or submitting an absentee ballot.)

The first day to vote an absentee ballot in the Clerk's Office is (Monday, July 25, 2016- which is the third Monday before the election). The deadline for voting an absentee ballot in the Clerk's Office is 5:00 p.m. on the Friday before the election, (Friday, August 5, 2016).

The Municipal Clerk will deliver voted ballots returned on or before Election day to the proper polling place or counting location before THE POLLS CLOSE ON (Tuesday, August 9, 2016). Any ballots received after the polls close will be counted by the Board of Canvassers if postmarked by Election Day and received no later than 4:00 p.m. on the Friday following the Election.

Notice of Meeting of the Local Board of Canvassers

At the close of voting on Election Day, pursuant to the provisions of Wis. Stat. § 19.84, the Election Inspectors at each polling place will convene as the Local Canvassing Board for the purpose of conducting the local canvass pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 7.51. If there are outstanding Absentee ballots, the Board of Canvassers will meet on Friday, August 12th (after the mail has been delivered). This meeting will be open to the public pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ 19.81-89.
