AMENDMENT ONE TO ORDINANCE 2-00

This amendment to Ordinance 2-00 subsection 5.0, Administration and Enforcement, is adopted pursuant to Wisconsin State Statutes 174.042.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF MUKWA by its Supervisors, provided that the Code of Ordinances, Town of Mukwa, BE AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Enforcement and Penalties

1. Dogs Running at Large

- a. <u>First Offense</u>: Written warning by certified receipt mail, plus expenses incurred by the Town (including but not limited to pick up and kenneling of animal).
- b. <u>Second Offense</u>: \$100.00 fine plus court costs, plus expenses incurred by the Town (including but not limited to pick up and kenneling of animal).
- c. <u>Third Offense</u>: \$200.00 fine plus court costs, plus expenses incurred by the Town (including but not limited to pick up and kenneling of animal).
 - d. Each day of violation shall constitute a separate offense.

2. Barking Dog Violation

- a. <u>First Offense</u> of a dog habitually barking or howling constituting a continuing annoyance to others shall be a written warning by certified receipt mail notifying owner of violation with a ten (10) day grace period.
 - b. Second Offense: \$50.00 fine plus court costs.
 - c. Third Offense: \$100.00 fine plus court costs.
 - d. Each day of violation shall constitute a separate offense.

2. <u>Listing Official</u>

The Town Treasurer is hereby designated as the listing official for dog license purposes.

3. Effective Date

This Amendment Number One to Ordinance 2-00 shall take effect upon passage by the Town Board of the Town of Mukwa and publication according to law.
