ORDINANCE 2-09

ORDINANCE DESIGNATING BROADWAY STREET AS A RESTRICTIVE SIX-TON HIGHWAY

The Town of Mukwa, Waupaca County, Wisconsin, by its Town Board of Supervisors, does ordain as follows:

Effective **March 16, 2009** the following town highway/road in the Town of Mukwa is designated a **Restrictive Six-Ton Highway** subject to the weight limits set forth in s. 348.16, Wis. Stats., unless increased by town ordinance:

“Broadway Street commencing at a point **311-feet** South of its intersection with Wisconsin State Highway 54 and continuing South to its terminus at Waupaca County Highway “X”.

The Town Chairperson, or his or her designee shall place appropriate traffic signs on the **above-described highway/road**, on or before the effective date of this ordinance.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication or posting as provided by law.

The above and foregoing ordinance was adopted by the Town Board of Supervisors of the Town of Mukwa, Waupaca County, Wisconsin, at a meeting held on the 16th day of March, 2009.
