## ORDINANCE NO. 2-83

An Ordinance Prohibiting Issuance of Alcohol Beverage Licenses for Nonpayment of Taxes, Assessments and Claims

THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF MUKWA, WISCONSIN, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Ordinance No. 2-83 relating to the regulation of alcoholic beverages in the Town of Mukwa, County of Waupaca, State of Wisconsin is created to read as follows:

Section 1 . LICENSE REGULATIONS. (1) DELINQUENT TAXES, ASSESSMENTS, ETC.

- (a) <u>PREMISES</u>. No initial or renewal alcoholic beverage license shall be granted for any premises for which taxes, assessments or other claim of the Town or County are delinquent and unpaid.
- (b) <u>PERSONS</u>. No initial or renewal alcoholic beverage license shall be granted to any person:
- 1. Delinquent in payment of any taxes, assessments or other claims owed to the Town.
- 2. Delinquent in payment of a forfeiture resulting from a violation of any ordinance of the Town.
  - 3. Delinquent in payment to the state or any state taxes owed.
  - 4. Delinquent in payment to the County or any County taxes owed.

Section  $\underline{2}$  . This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
